

Fabricator – 1st Shift



Work Activities:

- Read and understand blueprints.
- Sanding and cleaning of parts.
- Follow written and oral instructions.
- Must be adaptable to a changing work environment, competing demands and able to deal with frequent change, delays, or unexpected events.
- Must clean work area at end of each shift or as required.
- Perform safe work habits.
- Must be able to bend, twist, climb and lift up to 50 pounds.
- Position will also include operating of all fabrication machines.
- Other duties as assigned by management.

Skills and Abilities:

- Minimum 5 years' experience in the manufacturing industry with skills in fabrication.
- Communication: Read and understand work related materials.
- Basic math skills to include but not limited to adding, subtracting, multiplication, division, conversions of fractions and decimals.
- Strong understanding in blueprint reading to accurately build products to specified tolerances.
- Knowledge in use of measuring instruments and the application of such instruments.
- Must be able to work both independently with little supervision and within a team-based environment to accomplish all aspects of welding and fabrication.
- Exceptional organizational skills, ability to prioritize work and reliability.
- Experience with circle track racing or race car chassis fabrication a plus.
- A firm knowledge with welding safety and OSHA requirements will be required.
- Communicates with management, production control, quality, and other shop personnel for assignments and to resolve any quality issues.
- Maintain equipment on a routine basis.
