Work Activities:

- Person will be responsible for installation of all aluminum, body, and parts into dirt track race car chassis.
- Prepping, sanding and painting of necessary parts prior to install.
- Follow written and oral instructions.
- Adapt to a changing work environment, completing demands and able to deal with frequent change, delays or unexpected events.
- Responsible for 5S and cleanliness of designated work areas on a daily basis.
- Perform safe work habits.
- Must be able to bend, twist, climb and lift up to 50 pounds.
- Assist in Production activities as needed, including but not limited to operating fabrication machines.
- Other duties as assigned by management.

Skills and Qualifications:

- MUST have a high degree of attention to detail!
 - If you don't consider yourself a perfectionist don't apply.
- MUST be able to fit and finish sheetmetal and body components in a fast-paced manner.
- MUST have a good work attitude and be a part of a TEAM.

- Focus on quality of product and attention to detail.
- Exceptional organizational skills, ability to prioritize work and reliability.
